4. Adrian has 1 ten-dollar bill, 2 five-dollar bills, 5 quarters, and 3 dimes. Does he have enough to buy 2 movie tickets and a souvenir poster? Explain.

5. TJ is saving up to buy a collector's DVD of his favorite movie. The DVD costs \$44.65. The amount of money TJ has is shown to the right. Does he have enough for the DVD? Explain.
